

## **MONKEY REHABILITATION CARER**

Bali (Dog) Adoption & Rehabilitation Centre (BARC) aims to rescue, rehabilitate and re-home the neglected street dogs and puppies of Bali. BARC relies solely on donations to improve the lives of animals in Bali. It receives no government or corporate funding. BARC aims to save the forgotten victims of Bali's wildlife trade. Many monkeys are stolen from their mothers, put on a chain or small cage and sold in local markets to live their lives out as entertainment or a trophy pet. The Long-Tailed Macaque and the Pig-Tailed Macaque are not endangered species, therefore there is no government funding for their care and rehabilitation. This is what BARC wants to change. BARC is in the process of creating Bali's 1st multi species sanctuary known as 'Warrior's Legacy' in Tabanan, Bali. We currently have 170 adult dogs, 2 rescue horses and 2 rescued pigs. We have plans to create a state-of-the-art all natural, open air jungle monkey enclosure for our rescued monkeys. This will include tree houses for sleeping and relaxing, hammocks, various forms of enrichment, a viewing deck natural water fall, secure fencing, indoor area for treatment and special care and trained monkey caretakers. We are looking for volunteer Monkey Rehabilitation Caretaker to help make this happen.

### Roles/ responsibilities include:

- Design, in consultation with BARC, of the enclosure.
- Supervision and quality control of its construction
- Acclimatizing the rescue monkeys with their new surrounds
- Socialisation and integration of the monkeys into a troop
- Creating an enrichment program for the monkeys
- Training of local staff to care for the monkeys' physical and mental health

### Skills/Qualification:

- Degree or qualifications in Zoology, Animal Science, Zoo Keeping, Animal Husbandry is not essential, but highly regarded.
- Field experience and passion for working with primates
- Experience rehabilitating monkeys which have received trauma and or cruelty in their lives.
- Ability to maintain high levels of animal welfare and experience in creating an enriched environment

- Ability to live and work in a remote location
- Ability to speak English essential, Bahasa Indonesian desirable, but not essential
- Ability to train local staff and transfer knowledge
- Able to commit to 6 month minimum contract

What BARC will offer

- Free accommodation in a natural hut dwelling on location and meal allowance
- Flight from Australia or domestically within Indonesia included
- Access to scooter for transport
